When we trust God and set our love upon Him, He promises to rescue us, place us in safety, and honor us. He **delivers us, lifts us up, and places us on high**.

The ultimate display of God’s love and power was demonstrated in the life of Jesus Christ. Jesus endured betrayal, suffering, and the cross, all out of His relentless love for us. He was mocked, beaten, and crucified by His enemies, yet He endured it all for our salvation. Through His blood, shed on the cross, we are cleansed from sin, and the New Covenant of grace, forgiveness, and eternal protection is established.

But the most powerful aspect of the story is the resurrection. **Jesus is alive today and forever**, proving that God’s power to save is not limited to the past. The same hand that raised Jesus from the dead is the same hand that reaches down to lift you up from whatever you face today. **Jesus’ resurrection** shows that death, despair, and the enemy have been defeated—and through Him, we are more than conquerors.

God's hand is never too short to save you. He is Risen! When you call on His name, His power is made real in your life, bringing strength, hope, and victory.
