"He Heard You the Moment You Prayed" – Daniel 9:23 & Job 42:10

PRAYER is powerful. In every season of life whether we're rejoicing or struggling, prayer connects us to the heart of God. It is a relationship with Father, an act of faith, and an expression of trust.

In **Daniel 9:23**, the angel says to Daniel, **"As soon as you began to pray, a word went out..."** Daniel was known for his unwavering devotion to God by praying three times daily. Even in exile, surrounded by ungodly influence, he remained faithful. And because of that faithfulness, God responded immediately. The moment Daniel's heart turned to prayer; heaven moved.

Our prayers don't go unnoticed. Even when answers seem delayed, God is working behind the scenes. His timing is perfect. His silence is never absence. He hears us the moment we pray.

We see this truth again in the life of Job. After unimaginable loss and suffering, Job remained faithful. But it was **after he prayed for his friends**—those who had misunderstood and misjudged him—that God **"restored his fortunes and gave him twice as much as he had before"** (**Job 42:10**). Job's act of forgiveness and intercession unlocked a new level of blessing.

There is power when we pray not only for ourselves, but for others even those who've hurt us. Intercession is a pathway to healing, restoration, and breakthrough.

These two stories: Daniel and Job remind us that:

- God responds to prayer.
- He esteems those who seek Him.
- And when we pray for others, we often unlock our own blessing.

He heard you the moment you prayed.
