Psalm 136 – "His Steadfast Love Endures Forever..."

As we enter this fall season, celebrating one year church anniversary, a season of thanksgiving, let us pause and reflect: Who is our God? What has He created? How has He delivered us, provided for us, and cared for us? Psalm 136 leads us through this reflection, with a truth repeated 26 times: **"His steadfast love endures forever."**

Reading and meditating this psalm is a reminder of God's unchanging love shown through our lives:

1. His Character (vv. 1–3): "Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good..."

Thanksgiving begins with knowing who God is. He is good. He is above all other powers. He is the Lord of lords. Giving thanks is not based on how we feel but on God's unchanging character.

2. His Creation (vv. 4–9): "To Him who by understanding made the heavens..."

Creation is not random; it is the result of divine love and power. Each sunset, each crisp breeze, each harvest field is a whisper of His faithfulness.

3. His Deliverance (vv. 10–15): "To Him who struck down the firstborn of Egypt..."

God's love is not just seen in creation but in how He rescues His people. In our own lives, He still delivers us from fear, from sin, from hopelessness. He still parts the seas (big problems) for us.

4. His Guidance and Provision (vv. 16–22): "To Him who led His people through the wilderness..."

God didn't just free Israel; He led them through the wilderness and gave them a place of belonging. He defeated enemies and kept His promises.

5. His Personal Care (vv. 23–25): "He remembered us in our low estate..."

Even when we feel forgotten or overlooked, God sees us. He feeds all creation. He knows our needs before we speak to him.

6. Our Response (v. 26): "Give thanks to the God of heaven..."

This is our invitation: to live as thankful people, grounded in the truth that His love never fails.

**His love endures forever.
Let every breath of this season become a word of thanks.
To God alone be the glory.**
