Psalm 62:5 – My soul, find rest in God; my hope comes from him.

I often wonder how is it possible for our soul to sit quietly and look to the Lord when life feels uncertain? Yet David reminds us that our hope doesn't come from what we see, but from *who* we trust.

When I think about this verse, I'm reminded of Joseph's life. He was born to loving parents, and God blessed him with a powerful vision that one day his family would bow before him. But when he shared that dream, instead of honor, he received hatred from his brothers. They sold him as a slave to the Ishmaelites, and he was taken to Egypt.

Even in slavery, God's hand was upon him. Joseph found favor in Potiphar's house and was placed in charge. Perhaps he felt some relief, seeing a glimpse of God's favor again. But suddenly, because of Potiphar's wife's false accusation, Joseph was thrown into prison.

What a painful, heartbreaking turn of events! A man with a heavenly dream, lifted up, then cast down again. His future looked dark, his path uncertain. Yet, I believe that in that prison, **Joseph's soul waited quietly before God.** He might not have understood the "why," but he trusted the **Who.** God was training him, shaping his heart for the promise ahead.

And at the right time, God fulfilled His word. Joseph was brought out of prison to interpret Pharaoh's dream and was made governor of Egypt. His brothers eventually bowed before him, and his family was restored just as God had shown him.

Truly, as Psalm 62:5 says, **"My hope comes from Him."**

Joseph's story reminds us that waiting on God is never wasted. Even when our circumstances seem unfair or our dreams feel delayed, God is working behind the scenes.

*The soul that waits quietly before God will see His promises unfold.
For in His time, He always fulfills His word.*
